Directions for Use

- Surface to be filled must be clean, dry and free from dust
- Cut seal and nozzle to suit width of gap. Fit to cartridge. Insert into caulking gun.
- 3. Apply with caulking gun, forcing product into the gap.
- Press in and smooth off with a spatula. Take care not to drag out applied filler from the gap. Use spatula to scrape off as much residue as possible from the timber surface to minimise sanding necessary.
- 5. Clean up with a damp cloth immediately.
- Allow to dry for at least 24 hours before sanding off any residue from timber surface. Allow longer time in colder weather or if residue left on timber is excessive.
- Stain and varnish/paint as desired. Ensure stain/varnish is not allowed to pool in the joint – lightly wipe off while wet if necessary.

Tips

Ensure sufficient product is applied into gap, if filling tongue and groove overlaps.

Re-apply filler if timber movement is excessive and movement capability is exceeded, or if a flush fill is desired.

Coverage

Covers 18 metres with a 3 mm bead.
